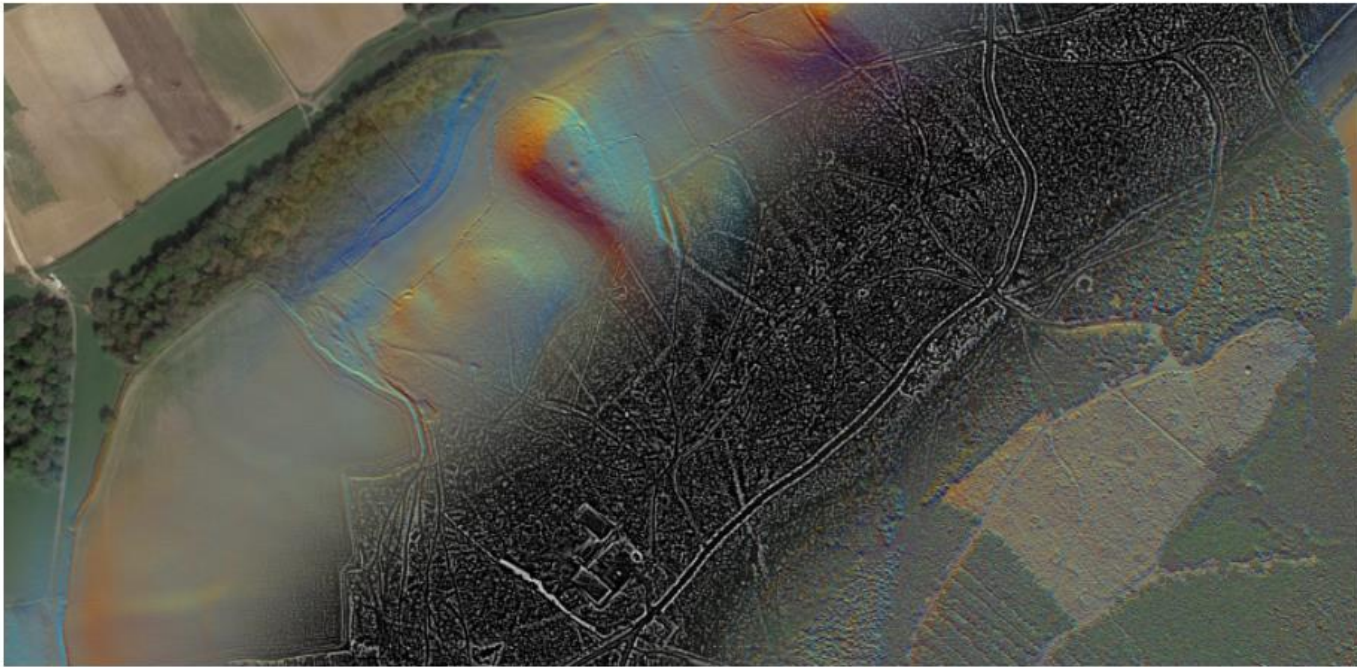

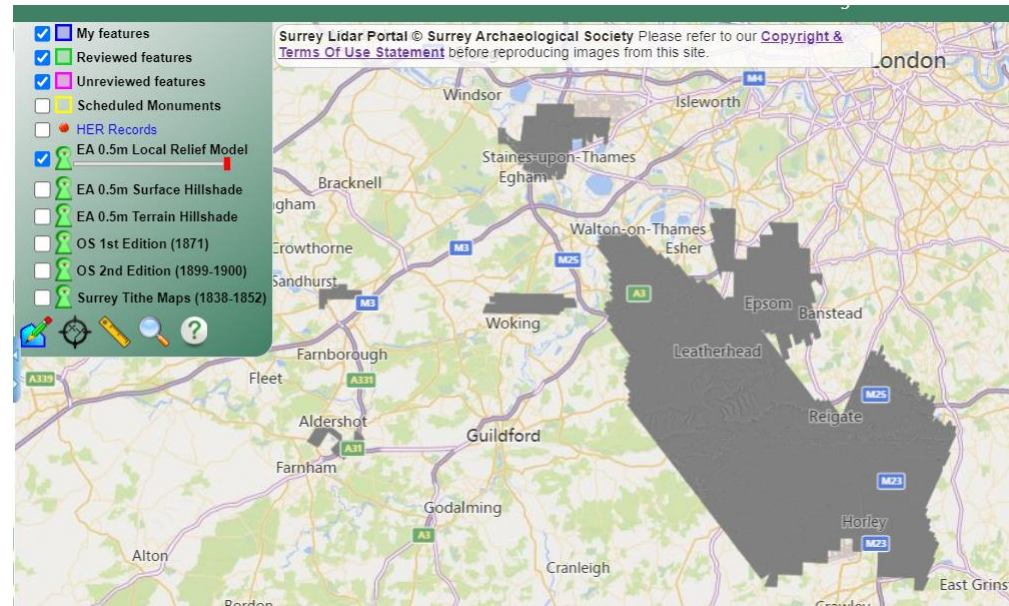


How to use this guide



The **Surrey LiDAR Portal** was established as a citizen science mapping project which will ultimately enhance the county's historic record of known archaeological and heritage features by using LiDAR data.

LiDAR is a fantastic resource which allows us a unique perspective on the landscape through which many, more subtle surface features can be traced. By having a sharp pair of eyes and some knowledge of the various monuments which might be found, you'll be well-equipped to interpret and record potential features which can tell us more about our local heritage!



Additional, more detailed tutorial guides are provided which instruct on how to interpret and understand some of the features you may encounter in the visualisations, including **How to Digitise and Record**, **Guide for Desk-Based Study**, **How to Read LiDAR**, **Gazetteer of Monument Types** and **Guide to Groundtruthing**.

Terms of use



To get started on the Surrey LiDAR Portal (surreylidar.org.uk), you will need an account. This is both to view the data and to allow any work you may do to be recorded.

It is suggested that you read fully the **Terms of Use**, which are available on the website and will be emailed to you when you register, however they are copied below for easy access:

- I undertake to conduct myself responsibly and with respect to others in regard to any language used or comments made on this website
- I will not reproduce or publish images (including both printed work and social media) derived from the lidar data and historic maps without acknowledging the relevant copyright holders: **LiDAR data © Environment Agency, visualised by PTS Consultancy; First edition Ordnance Survey and Tithe maps © Surrey History Centre and J David Young** (please note permission from Surrey History Centre must be obtained to use these images for publication purposes); **Second edition Ordnance Survey maps © National Library of Scotland**
- I will not use the data on this website for commercial purposes
- I will not trespass on private land without express permission from the landowner(s) as part of any investigation or activity based on the data contained in this website
- I will adhere to the [Countryside Code](#) when investigating any sites in the field (e.g. leaving gates and property as they are found, ensuring crops are not damaged, not disturbing wildlife, etc)



Terms of use



- I will not undertake metal-detecting, excavation or survey on any sites without express permission and consent from the landowner(s) and any other relevant organisation where prior consent and licenses are needed (Note that any Scheduled Ancient Monument, Ministry of Defence property or Site of Special Scientific Interest (SSSI) has strict regulations in particular and requires written consent from the relevant statutory authorities in addition to the landowner for potential fieldwork)



1) Open the website and click on 'Register' in the top right corner.



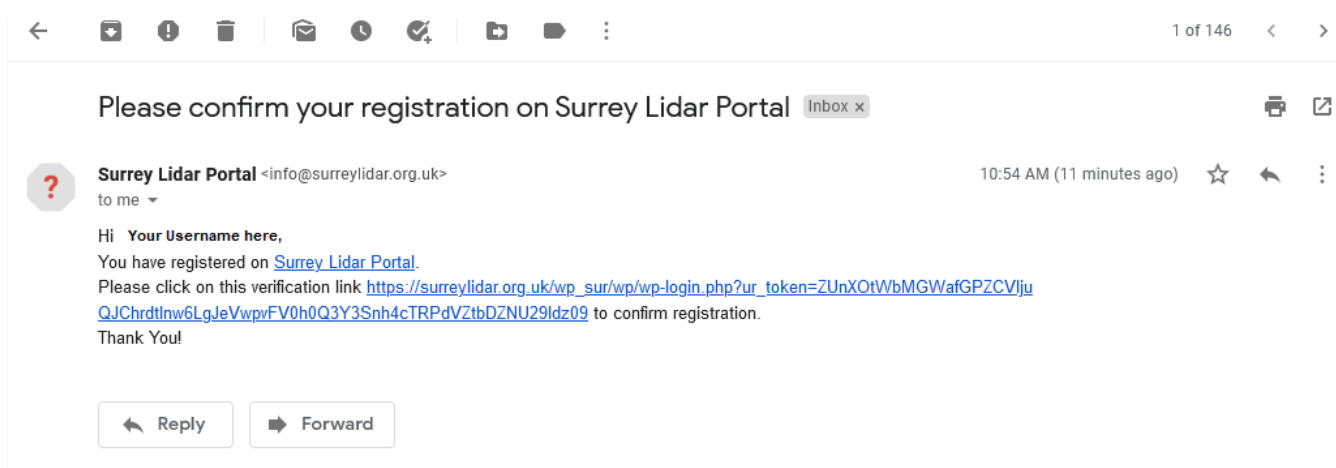
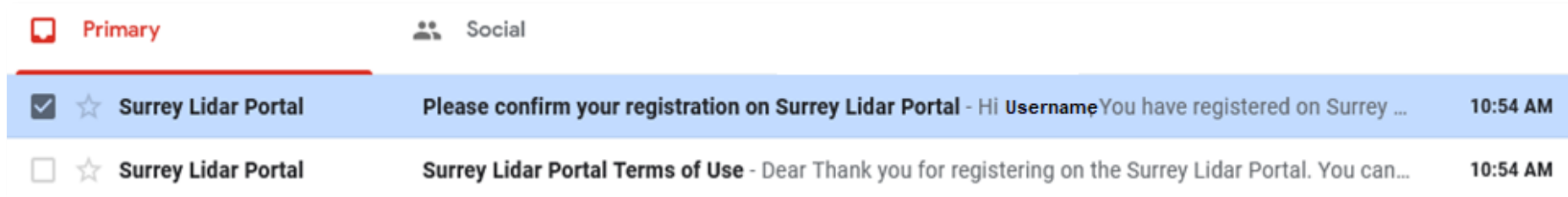

3) Check your email account for two emails from **Surrey LiDAR Portal** (info@surreylidar.org.uk), one which includes the Terms of Use and one which contains the link for you to verify your account.



If you don't find an email from info@surreylidar.org.uk, check your spam folder.

2) Fill out the form seen here by entering a username, email address, password, first and last name. Check the box to agree to the Terms of Use, and then click Submit.

Your username is of your choosing, but we recommend a combination of letters and numbers. If a username is already taken, you will have to choose another.

We also recommend that you choose it wisely, as it will be publicly visible to others on the Portal if you choose to comment on or make a record (if you don't comment on records, your username will not make it onto the visible portions of the website).

Your name and email will NEVER be made public on the site!

You don't have to pick the default password offered, but please make sure that you use a **strong password of at least 6 characters with a mix of letters, numbers and punctuation.**

4) Click on the link in your email to verify your account. You will be redirected to the Surrey LiDAR portal login page where you will see a green notice 'User Successfully Registered'.
